

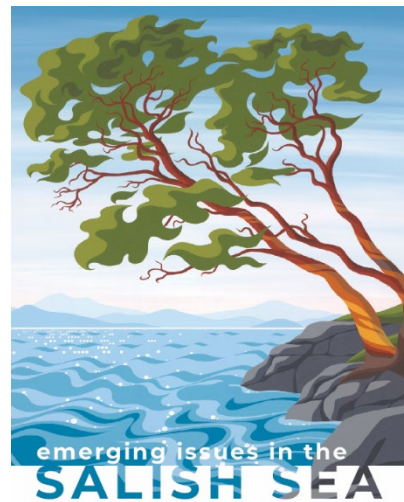

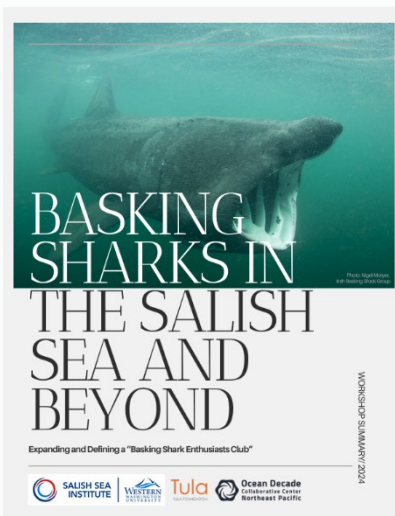
Emerging Issues in the Salish Sea Vol. 5
